Camping Rules and Regulations		
1. Payment must be made in full by June 28 to secure your site. Any site not paid for by June 28 will be forfeited and the site will be made available for rental.		
2. You will be assigned a site number and receive two stickers; one must be displayed on your camper and the other on your vehicle An additional sticker will be issued for your stock trailer. Letters with site numbers and stickers will be mailed in early July.		
3. There is an additional (\$25 for 110 volt) (\$30 for 220 volt) per day charge for electric to stock trailers.		
4. There will be a \$100 surcharge for breakers damaged due to overloading. The Fair employed electrician will remove any lines tapped directly into the electric without permission and the owner fined \$30.		
5. <u>DO NOT RUN GRAY OR BLACK WATER ON THE</u> trailer. Dumping is available during fairweek. Please made before having trailer dumped.	GROUND. A contracted sewer service check with the fair office for the days a	e is available for you to dump your and dumping fees. Payment must be
6. By order of the Chautauqua County Health Department, all campsites are equipped with anti–syphoning flow devices. Upon departure, please leave these devices in place. A \$15 fine will be charged for missing devices.		
7. Pets are allowed if on a leash, kept quiet and controlled on your site. Pets need to be vaccinated for rabies. You must clean up after your pet. Pets must not be left unattended. Pit Bulls, Doberman Pinchers, Chow-Chows, Wolf-Hybrids, and any other dogs a Fair Board Member determines to be a danger to the public are prohibited. Pets may not be taken onto the midway or into any of the barns or buildings.		
8. ABSOLUTELY NO CAMPFIRES!		
9. Please place your trash in the trashcans placed throughout the campgrounds. These trash cans will be emptied daily.		
10. Grilling: any use of a grill, hibachi, or any grilling unit must be at least 10 feet from any camping unit.
